

At the PCA meet Eli Eash had an astonishing drop of over a minute in his 200 free and Evan Eash dropped over 10 seconds in his 50 fly. At the Purdue meet Olivia Moore placed top 8 in all her events and earned another divisionals cut in the 50 back.

While most PCA senior swimmers represent Plainfield High School, there are a few who are representing other schools.
